



Trail Construction Projects

East Fork of the Big Dry Creek Trail

This section of eight foot wide concrete trail will connect McArthur Ranch Road, from the north, to Rocky Heights Middle School near Monarch Parkway to the south with neighborhood connections from the drainage to the neighborhood west of the schools. East/West Regional Trail

Douglas County will be building three sections of the regional trail in the area near Lone Tree west to Redstone Park. The west section will be eight foot wide crusher fines (soft surface) and will run from the Back County community west between Chatfield Estates and the Weatherstone community and connect with the Plum Valley Trail. There will be neighborhood connections to the north in this segment. The trail will then continue from the north end of Plum Valley Trail, cross at Highlands Ranch Parkway, continue north on the west side of the Spring Gulch Dam, then turn west and connect with the Spring Gulch Trail at the southeast corner of Redstone Park by the soccer fields. Construction is anticipated to begin in June.

Dad Clark Trail Connection to Toepfer Park

A local connection (eight foot wide concrete) from the Tresana community will bridge across the Dad Clark drainage and connect with the Dad Clark Trail at Toepfer Park on the east side of the park.
