

## To Participate And Become A McGruff House

1. All adults living in the household, 18 and over must complete the application form below.
2. Applicants then submit the completed form to either Kim Hatchell (address below) or to their school for processing.
3. Applicants will receive a Records Check Application to complete and sign, authorizing the Douglas County Sheriff's Office (DCSO) to perform a confidential law enforcement background check.
4. After approval by DCSO, participants must attend an orientation meeting at the school.
5. Students will also learn about McGruff programs and meet McGruff at a school assembly designed to teach kids about the programs and "Stranger Awareness".
6. After that – McGruff Houses can help kids when needed!
