Co-existing With Coyotes Public Meeting

The Highlands Ranch Metro District and the Colorado Division of Wildlife (CDOW) are partnering to present a public meeting to provide tips on co-existing with coyotes. The meeting will be held Thursday, March 11 at 6:00 p.m. at the District Office Building, 62 W. Plaza Drive, Highlands Ranch.

Metro District natural resources staff, Metro District Park Rangers and staff from the CDOW will help residents better understand coyotes. Attendees will learn about:

- Protecting your pet
- Discouraging coyote activity in and around your yard
- Staying safe on the trails and natural open space areas
