FOR METRO DISTRICT DIRECTOR ELECTION**

Individuals interested in running for a director seat on the Highlands Ranch Metro District Board of Directors must submit a self-nomination and acceptance form by 5 p.m. on Friday, February 26. The forms must be submitted at the Metro District offices, 62 Plaza Drive on the southwest corner of Broadway and Plaza Drive. Forms are available at the Metro District office Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m., or at [www.highlandsranch.org](http://www.highlandsranch.org).

Four seats are open, one in each of the following Metro District regions: Northwest, Southeast, West Central and South Central. One director will be elected to a four-year term for each of the four regions noted above.

The Metro District's polling place election will be held Tuesday, May 4 from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. at the Metro District office at 62 W. Plaza Drive, located on the southwest corner of Broadway and Plaza Drive. If you signed up for a permanent mail-in ballot through Douglas County, you will receive your Metro District ballot in the mail.
