**CANDIDATES SOUGHT FOR AN APPOINTMENT TO
METRO DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

Individuals who are interested in being considered for appointment to the Highlands Ranch Metro District Board of Directors must submit a letter of interest by 5 p.m. on Friday, April 16. The letter may be dropped off at the Metro District offices, 62 Plaza Drive on the southwest corner of Broadway and Plaza Drive, or mailed to Terry Nolan, Highlands Ranch Metro District, 62 Plaza Drive, Highlands Ranch, 80129.

Candidates must be registered to vote in the state of Colorado and must live in, or own property in the southwest region of the Highlands Ranch Metro District. For a region map, please visit www.highlandsranch.org, under the Newsflash section, or stop by the Metro District offices. Board members will appoint someone to fill the seat recently vacated by Ryan Stuart. The newly-appointed director will serve the remainder of the term until May 2012. Stuart announced his resignation from the Metro District Board of Directors effective March 19 after accepting a position as district court magistrate in the First Judicial District. The Colorado Code of Judicial Conduct prohibits judicial officers from serving in any political roles or on any elected government boards.
