### Special Permits

Please contact the Metro Districts at least 60 days prior to the date of your event for any of the following uses that require a special permit:

**Sales of goods or services** - Groups or individuals

That plan to charge entry fees or sell merchandise must apply for a special permit.

**Special events** - Events for more than 50 people, or advertised to the public, require the Metro District's approval before a permit is issued.

**Sale of alcoholic beverages** - The sale of alcoholic beverages while using the park requires the Metro District's approval before a permit can be issued. The applicant must secure all licenses required by Colorado law to sell alcoholic beverages.

### Permittee's Responsibilities

1. Permits must be available, upon request, during park use.
2. Permits may be used only by the person/group to whom they are issued.
3. Facilities must be left in the condition in which they were found.
4. Motorized vehicles are not permitted on sidewalks, paths, or trails.

4. Dogs are not permitted in the park.
5. Scooters, bicycles and skateboards must be dismounted in the park.
6. Amplified sound is prohibited prior to 9 a.m. and after 10 p.m..
4. The following are prohibited: Glass containers, littering/dumping, misuse of public property, fires (except in grills), golf, fireworks, firearms/archery, model rockets and airplanes, disorderly conduct, and harassment of wildlife.

# The Ultimate Park Experience

Civic Green Park is the latest addition to the Highlands Ranch park system. Offering unsurpassed natural beauty as the backdrop for music, arts and endless family entertainment, Civic Green Park is your community playground.

Situated in the heart of Highlands Ranch, the park is a blend of meandering paths, gardens, picnic shelters, dancing fountains, and an amphitheatre with grass seating that can accommodate up to 3,000 people.

Families can enjoy picnics, birthday parties, weddings, films, or just cool off in the fountain plaza on a hot summer day!

The Park is available to rent for community events such as concerts, fund-raisers, performing arts performances, holiday celebrations, graduation and birthday parties, cultural events and company outings.

## Amenities

### **Stage**

32-foot x 32-foot floor area; 19 feet high at center; 16 feet high at sides.

### **Lighting**

Two poles; theatrical fixtures with six spotlights each; gel frames available. 14 overhead fixtures with dimmers under pavilion.

### **Electrical**

Two sets of four-outlet, 20 amps each. One 200-amp, three-phase; camlok 1016 for lights. One 100-amp, three-phase; camlok 1016 for sound. Sound system is not currently available, but is available for rent.

### **Amphitheatre Seating**

Grass amphitheatre seating for up to 3,000 people.

### **Fountain Plaza**

35 foot x 50 foot fountain with spray features or paved area for seating.

### **Parking**

Public parking is available in the nearby RTD lot; and in the Highlands Ranch Town Center parking garage. Parking is subject to event criteria.

**The Overlook Shelter** is equipped with a charcoal grill and electrical outlet. It is close to the playground, water fountain, upper fountains, and restrooms. It has four picnic tables and accommodates up to 40 people.

**The Stage Shelter.** It does not have a grill. It features eight picnic tables, accommodating up to 100 people.

**Arboretum Shelter.** This shelter is not yet built. Construction will begin late summer of 2006.
